### **REMODELING NEWS**

Have you seen the ten bathrooms that Facilities Mike and his Team remodeled this winter? What an improvement! This is where you can find them --- two on the second floor quad east of the pool, two on the second floor quad west of the pool, two on the Anchor aisle in the east side bathhouse area, two in the corner of the second floor of the square, and two in the Bistro.

But there's more. There are now four private showers --- each with its own changing area --- in the east side bathhouse area. There's one on the Island aisle, one on Beach, and two on Driftwood.

### **OFFICE NEWS**

Just about everything that we do these days circles around to covid ---- in life as in at the Beach Club. The space in the office is very tight. Please be sure to wear your mask whenever you enter to conduct any business. Keep in mind that we need to protect our employees as well as ourselves.

So let's review our mask policy. Mask on when you're moving around the facility, mask on in the pool area, mask on when you enter/leave the Bistro, mask on when you get up from your table in the Bistro, mask on when you're in the office. If it's a cool day and there are very few people on the beach and you're going for a walk and you can easily stay six feet away from anyone, then don't don the mask. If it's early in the morning and it's quiet at the facility and you're walking around decks that are empty of people, then don't don the mask. In both cases, just keep it with you in case you come across someone. Come on, common sense.

### **CABANA DECK NEWS**

Old rules take on new significance these days. An existing rule states that there must be a 42-inch clear walkway at the railing on the cabana decks. This is even more important now so that space can be provided for folks to walk by the cabanas. Please be sure that you situate your furniture so as to provide that 42-inch clear pathway. In addition, the one-way traffic patterns are a help. It's all about safety this year, folks, so cooperation is to everyone's benefit.

## **FOOD SERVICE NEWS**

Cash will now be accepted in all Food & Beverage venues.

Other than that, status quo in F&B. As a friendly reminder, below is a re-print of some of last week's BISTRO NEWS. Definitely something to look forward to.

The Bistro will open on Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup> and will be open Tuesday through Saturday from 5:30pm to 8:30pm. In keeping with the Governor's mandates, we will be able to accommodate a maximum of 40 diners at one time. The Restaurant Bar will not be available for seating. The menu will soon be posted on our website.

Also according to the Governor's guidelines, reservations are **REQUIRED**. Reservations can be made on the Sea Breeze Bistro page on our website by clicking on OpenTable or you can go to the Bistro to make reservations in person. Telephone reservations will not be accepted. A maximum of six people will be allowed at a table. There will be no communal table.

## **POOL NEWS**

The Governor's new Executive Order allows pools to open and allows a maximum of 15 people in the pool at one time. Accordingly, our pool will open on Saturday, June 13 from 10am to 6pm on a preliminary basis. We say "preliminary" because we've developed a pool policy that complies with the 15-person mandate, but we're not sure if it will work. On the other hand, it may work so well that we might move to the next step. So we might come back to you on the morning of Monday, June 15 and announce a change. So check your email.

The first 20 minutes of the hour will be adult swim. A staff member will be posted at the pool gate. S/he will record the name and unit number of each of the first 15 adults who want to enter the pool. As soon as 15 people are registered to enter the pool, the gate will be closed.

The next forty minutes of the hour will be children's swim. The children will line up at the pool gate. The staff member at the gate will record the name and unit number of the children who want to enter the pool. S/he will also record the name and unit number of any adult who wants to accompany a child. The adult will inform the staff member if s/he just wants to sit and watch the child or if s/he wants to accompany the child into the pool. As soon as 15 people are registered to enter the pool, the gate will be closed. Please explain to your children that there is no guarantee that they will get into the pool.
