REMINDERS . . .

- Gate hours: 8am to 10pm currently. Effective July 2, 8am to 1am Sunday through Thursday and 8am to 2am Friday and Saturday.
- 2020 Membership Pass is required at the Gate. 2019 pass no longer suffices to gain entry.
- Guests will be allowed on weekdays *starting on Tuesday, July 7*.
 - Guest Fee is \$15 all day.
 - No After-4 pass.
 - No parking fee.
- You may exchange a membership for 42 Voucher Guest Passes to be used on *weekdays*.
- House Guest Pass is available for \$200. May be used on *weekdays*.
- Additional memberships may be purchased. Priced at \$650. The \$300 additional membership is reserved for someone who *permanently* lives in the home of an owner when all other members on the unit also *permanently* live in the home of an owner.

- Pool is limited to 15 people at a time. Two 10-minute cleaning periods and two 20-minute swimming periods every hour. *Adult Swim 10am to 11am.* Pool is open 10am to 6pm daily.
- Individual tennis lessons are available. Group lessons are limited to four people *living in the same house.* Call Beth-Anne Rafanelli at 374-0025 to book your lessons.
- Trivia Night started this week. Meets every Tuesday at 6:30pm. Pit Bar and Pit Grill will be open, so you *may not bring your own food and/or beverage into the Pit on Trivia Night.*
- No Card League this season.
- Only *two patrons* at a time in the Logo Loft
